2. Contents
 - Audio, Textgrid and EGG files for:
 - 3 Male Speakers (M1, M3, M10) and
 - 7 Female Speakers (F2, F4, F5, F6, F7, F8, F9)
3. Filename convention
 - Eg. 2008-11-21-1330-01_Audio.wav
 - The most relevant number is the final one. In the above example, it is 01. This number refers to the number of the word in the word list.
4. Transcription
 - Breathiness was indicated with the use of a following equals sign “=”
 - Preceding voiceless aspiration was indicated with the use of a *following* “h” (*i.e.* /^h/)
 - Preceding voiced aspiration was indicated with a *following* capitalized “H” (*i.e.* /^{h̥}/)
 - The transcriptions represent target pronunciations, and do not necessarily reflect the actual production of the speaker.
