

Black Miao Notes

1. Data collection credit: Jianjing Kuang of UCLA, in Shidong Kou (Shih-Tung-K'ou), Taijiang (T'ai-Kung) county of Guizhou (Kweichow) province, China, in summer 2011.
2. Contents:
 - Audio, EGG recordings and TextGrids
 - 8 speakers: 8 male speakers
3. Filename convention
 - Files for 5 out of the 8 speakers follows a similar convention:
 - Filenames have 3 bits of information: the speaker, the speaker ID, and the recording number. E.g. *zhangxueqi_m2_01*
 - For the other 2 speakers, filenames just consist of the speaker name and recording number. E.g. *liuhua_01*
 - For speaker M1, the filename consists of the speaker name, speaker ID and word. E.g. *Liushilong_m1_cji45*
4. Wordlist
 - The wordlist attached consists of two parts:
 - A list of words with transcriptions and glosses divided into two categories: minimal sets + others
 - A list of filenames with the corresponding transcription of the word.
 - Users are advised to consult both of these pieces of information when using the recordings
5. Transcription
 - The two digits in the string indicates tone
