1. Data collection credit: Jianjing Kuang of UCLA, fieldwork in two southern Yi villages (Xinping and Jiangcheng) in summer 2009.
2. Contents
 - 2 villages
 - village 1: 3 female speakers (F1, F2, F3) & 3 male speakers (M1, M2, M3)
 - village 2: 3 female speakers (F1, F2, F5) & 3 male speakers (M1, M2, M3)
3. Filename convention
 - Filenames have 3 bits of information: the speaker, the sound, and the repetition number.
 - The labeling convention is: speaker_sound_repetition
 - Example: F1_buu33_01
4. Transcription
 - An underscore (_) in the string indicates the tense feature
 - The two digits in the string indicates tone
