  - 4 female speakers (F1-F4) & 5 male speakers (M1-M5)
  
3. Filename convention
  - Filenames have 3 bits of information: the speaker, the sound, and the repetition number.
  - The labeling convention is: speaker\_sound\_repetition
    - Example: F1\_ba33\_01
  
4. Transcription
  - An underscore ( \_ ) in the string indicates the tense feature
  - The two digits in the string indicates tone
